

UNICEF estimates there are over 153 million orphans in the world.

Everyday, 5700 more children are added to this number because of poverty, abandonment, death of their parents, and abuse.

There is not a system in place in third world countries for foster families or adoption and not enough orphanages to care for the growing numbers..

Hope Story Missions is an extension of Lennox Barnett Ministries, whose mission is to share hope through story and song in places that feel hopeless.

Hope Story Missions travel to orphanages and under-resourced schools in countries like Haiti, Jamaica, Kenya, Dominican Republic, Trinidad and more.

We share messages of God's love for his children and tell stories of hope and redemption.

We encourage and challenge orphans that they can become highly effective contributors to society while providing tangible and sustainable resources for our partnering orphanages.





KENBE HOUSE PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Partnering with Christianville Ministry and a local missionary, Hope Story Missions has a vision to renovate The Kenbe House into a transition home for young people who are aging out of area orphanages but have not yet been given the resources and opportunities necessary to transition into independent adulthood.

In Spring of 2021, LBM Is hoping to take a team to Gressier, Haiti to renovate the home and begin the re-establishment of sustainable living programs. We have big dreams for these orphans to transition from a life of loneliness and devastation to becoming a productive member of their new family.

BUDGET

The total estimated Project Budget for PHASE ONE of The Kenbe Project is \$25,000 for January-May 2021. This budget includes the costs of necessary supplies. labor and construction, repairs, furnishings, travel expenses, and more.


OPPORTUNITY
